2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Hazardous ingredients: TOLUENE >90%

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: Highly flammable. Irritating to skin. Harmful: danger of serious damage to health by prolonged exposure through inhalation. Possible risk of harm to the unborn child. Harmful: may cause lung damage if swallowed. Vapours may cause drowsiness and dizziness.

Other hazards: In use, may form flammable / explosive vapour-air mixture.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: There may be irritation and redness at the site of contact. Blistering may occur.

Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness. The vision may become blurred.

Ingestion: There may be irritation of the throat. There may be vomiting. Inhalation of fumes from the stomach may cause symptoms similar to direct inhalation.

Inhalation: There may be irritation of the throat with a feeling of tightness in the chest. Drowsiness or mental confusion may occur. There may be loss of consciousness. There may be congestion of the lungs causing severe shortness of breath.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

Skin contact: Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water. Consult a doctor.

Eye contact: Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Transfer to hospital for specialist examination.

Ingestion: Wash out mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting. If conscious, give half a litre of water to drink immediately. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

Inhalation: Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. If unconscious, check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media: Carbon dioxide. Alcohol or polymer foam. Dry chemical powder. Use water spray to cool containers.

Exposure hazards: Highly flammable. Vapour may travel considerable distance to source of ignition and flash back. Forms explosive air-vapour mixture. In combustion emits toxic fumes of carbon dioxide / carbon monoxide.

Protection of fire-fighters: Wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions: Do not attempt to take action without suitable protective clothing - see section 8 of SDS. Eliminate all sources of ignition. Turn leaking containers leak-side up to prevent the escape of liquid.

Environmental precautions: Do not discharge into drains or rivers. Contain the spillage using bunding.

Clean-up procedures: Absorb into dry earth or sand. Transfer to a closable, labelled salvage container for disposal by an appropriate method. Wash the spillage site with large amounts of water.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling requirements: Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area. Smoking is forbidden. Avoid the formation or spread of mists in the air.

Storage conditions: Store in cool, well ventilated area. Keep away from sources of ignition. Keep container tightly closed.

Suitable packaging: Must only be kept in original packaging.
